Cameron Peak Wildfire 2020 What you need to know

Register to receive emergency alerts and evacuation notices on your cell phone and by email

Sign up now at <u>www.nocoalert.org</u>

Text the keyword LCEVAC to #888777 for Cameron Peak info

Leaving early gives you the best chance of surviving a wildfire, and keeps roads clear for firefighters and law enforcement.

Do not wait to be advised to leave if there is a possible threat to your home, evacuation route, or possible road congestion.

READY What to do right now

Create defensible space around your home right now!

Remove combustible brush and firewood away from your home, and relocate patio furniture away from your home and store indoors.

Have your Go Kit ready!

Prescription medications, important documents, emergency supplies, family communication plan, and plans for pets & livestock.

SET Prepare and be aware

Be Evacuation Ready!

Know at least two evacuation routes, and plan for traffic congestion

Ensure your vehicle has a full tank of gas

Have your Go Kit ready, and dress accordingly

Alert your neighbors, and ensure pets are ready for travel

Act early- do not delay!

Do not wait to be advised to leave if there is a threat -leave early!

Go to a predetermined location- a relative's house, motel, etc.
